## diggiddy**doggy**daycare **deed of release**

- 1) The Dog Owner understands that all canine clients enrolled within diggiddy**doggy**daycare (DDDC) must be at least 11 weeks of age &/or 5-7 days after their initial C5 vaccination (C3 not acceptable).
- 2) Canine clients over the age of 6 months must be neutered or spayed (puppies between the ages of 11 weeks and 6 months are excluded).
- 3) Proof of up-to-date C5 vaccination must be provided. C5 certification can be provided by your veterinarian.
- 4) Your dog must approach and enter and leave the Centre on lead at all times.
- 5) Dog Owner will need to confirm that their dog has not been ill within in the past 30 days. DDDC reserves the right to request Veterinarian certification of the dog's health.
- 6) The Dog Owner acknowledges that DDDC is a cage free environment and their dog will be interacting off leash with other dogs on the premises.
- 7) The Dog Owner agrees to disclose any known aggressive/behavioural issues prior to their induction to DDDC.
- 8) The Dog Owner accepts that prior to membership to DDDC their dog must undergo an Admission Behavioural Assessment conducted by a qualified canine behavioural specialist and be found to be suitable for the DDDC environment. The non-refundable cost of the assessment is \$21.00 (incl.GST) and is charged to the Dog Owner. The Dog Owner further understands that while the results of the Admission Behavioural Assessment will dictate whether or not their dog is suitable for membership at the DDDC facility, their dog may require reassessing in the future, particularly if there is a negative change in its behaviour. Although this Assessment reduces the risk a dispute occurring between dogs, the Dog Owner accepts that it does not eliminate this risk.
- 9) The Dog Owner understands and agrees that there is the risk of certain injuries when within a dog daycare facility.
- 10) The Dog Owner understands that if their dog is found diagnosed as having fleas or worms their dog will be treated immediately and the cost of treatment charged to the Dog Owner. The Dog Owner will be informed via phone call or consultation upon pick up.
- 11) The Dog Owner understands that should any dog become ill or injured whilst in the DDDC centre, the DDDC staff will administer basic first-aid and contact the owner immediately if transfer to a veterinary clinic for further treatment is required. Any expenses incurred are at the cost of the Dog Owner. The DDDC will make every effort to contact the dogs veterinarian, however reserves the right to transfer to its nominated clinic; Port Phillip Animal Hospital, 46-48 Mills Street, Albert Park.
- 12) The Dog Owner acknowledges that DDDC staff may use certain forms of corrective behaviour techniques (in no way detrimental to the dog) to maintain an enjoyable and safe environment for all dogs.
- 13) The Dog Owner understands that if their dog begins to display aggressive behaviour DDDC may terminate its membership. Any monies in credit will be refunded to the Dog Owner.
- 14) DDDC is not responsible for any accidental death of pet of the nature of pre-existing health condition or natural disasters (fire, storm, flood, etc.)
- 15) The Dog Owner shall be liable for all expenses incurred by DDDC in obtaining treatments for their dog(s).
- 16) DDDC is not a boarding facility. And thus all dogs must be collected by the respected owners prior to the centre's closing time of 6:30pm. All late pickups will incur a surcharge of \$1 per 1-minute increment.
- 17) The Dog Owner understands that a "no show" or "cancellation" without 24 hours notice will incur a full charge of pre-booked daycare visit.
- 18) The Dog Owner accepts all liability and shall indemnify DDDC, its employees, agents and/or representatives from any claims or actions of any kind arising from any loss, injury or harm that their dog sustains or inflicts upon another dog or person whilst in the DDDC facility. The Dog Owner shall reimburse DDDC for all services rendered, and services sought from third parties such as medical treatment in relation to any loss, injuries or harm sustained by your dog or inflicted by your dog upon a person whilst at the DDDC facility.
- 19) The Dog Owner agrees to be responsible for any property damages by dog.
